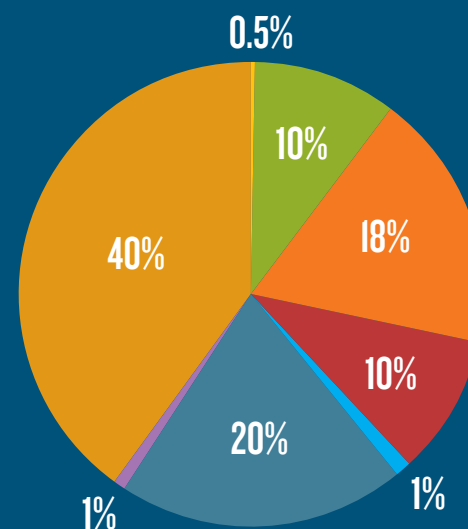

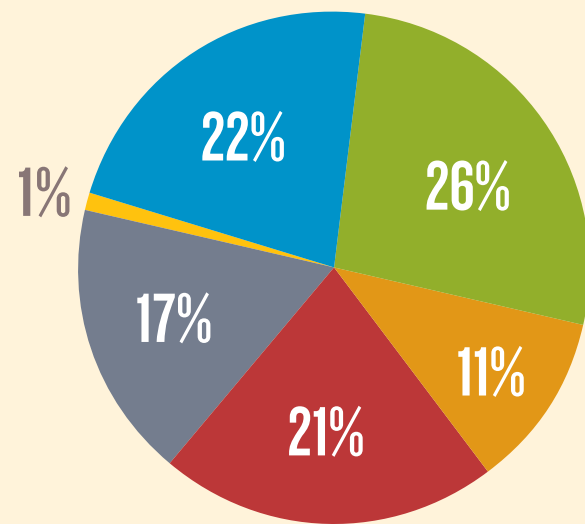

Our students showcase their talents in a range of ensembles, from String Orchestra to Symphonic Band to Chorus.



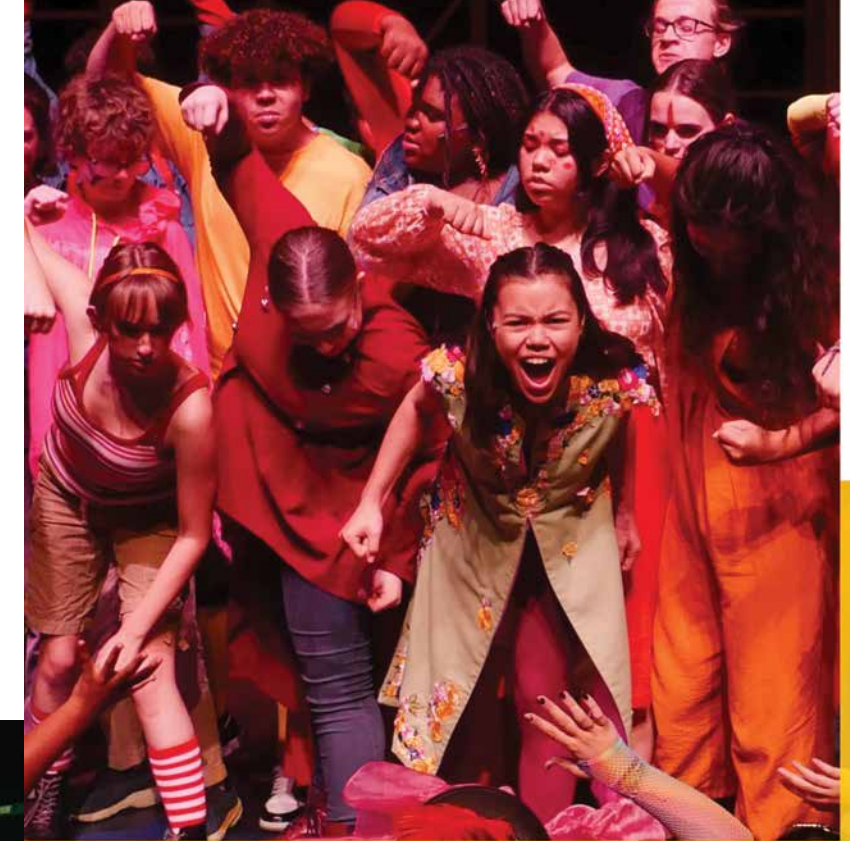
Visual Arts

Campus Ministry

With a Confirmation Program for 10-12th graders, inclusive Family Masses, and senior leadership opportunities with the Campus Ministry Team, O'Dowd's culturally relevant ministries prepare students to "go and set the world on fire."

AFFORDING O'DOWD

Ensuring Access for All Students

The O'Dowd community is deeply committed to accessibility. Our tuition covers roughly 88 percent of our expenses, with the generous philanthropy of our current families, alumni, and friends of O'Dowd fulfilling the remaining operating budget. We do this because we are dedicated to ensuring that O'Dowd is affordable to as many families as possible. Paired with tuition assistance, which funds 30 percent of our students, we remain steadfast in making O'Dowd a place of belonging for every family.

Tuition Assistance

O'Dowd uses a company called FACTS to help assess need, collect income information, and upload tax documentation.
